Mahatma Gandhi Study Centre Annual Report-2017-18

Introduction:

Mahatma Gandhi was a versatile personality. He minutely observed and studied social, educational, political, economical and religious values. His thoughts are based on these values. He has a perspective towards life. He found the truth in life. He not only led India to freedom but the welfare of entire humanity is the crux of his thoughts. He put before the world a philosophy which is based on practice. He adopted the path of truth, non-violence and Satyagrah. He gave the message of "Live and let live". Mahatma Gandhi study centre at J.E.S.College, Jalna is striving hard to spread Gandhiji's message and thought to all the elements of society. The centre has been conducting various programmes in Jalna city and Jalna district since last twelve years.

Special speech for Prisoners:

Mahatma Gandhi Study Centre and Mumbai Survoday Mandal organized a special lecture for Prisoners in district prison, Jalna. Both the organizations also conducted Gandhian Thought examination and distributed certificates in the function on 16 September, 2017. Mahatma Gandhi Study Centre in collaboration with Mumbai Survoday Mandal organized a special lecture of former Vice-Principal Prof. B.Y. Kulkarni, conducted 'Gandhian Thought inspiration examination and distributed books to the prisoners in the district prison, Jalna.
