Analysis:

In the academic year 2018-19, the feedback of 20% students i.e. 387 students was taken. Out of the 387 students 85% students reported that 100% syllabus was completed, where as nobody said that the syllabus completion was less than 75%.

90% students said that teachers delivered well prepared lecture in the class where as above 90% students replied that teachers communication was effective in the class room.

82% students said that teachers encourage them to read reference books of their respective subjects. 80% students strongly agree that they get internet facility in the college.

Maximum students mentioned that they are regularly promoted for internship, inplant training and field work. 78% students agreed that they are provided mentorship for social, emotional and academic growth in the college.

Action taken report:

After analysis student's satisfaction survey report, IQAC suggested the Principal to expand infrastructure facility and e-learning facility.
